This Recording Fee is to be collected by the Show-giving Club and paid to the American Kennel Club. If a dog is entered in more than one class in the show, the Recording Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (American Kennel Club Rule, Chapter 11, Section 2).

**RETURNED CHECKS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Show Superintendent will add a \$20.00 fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**TELEGRAPH, TELEPHONE and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.**

**ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS** without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are **NOT ACCEPTABLE**.

**CANADIAN EXHIBITORS** make fees payable in **U.S. FUNDS**.

**NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.**

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

**CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.**

**DOGS MAY ARRIVE** any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

**JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS.** Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the Show Superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

**ALL DOGS PRESENT** must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercise pens.

**CLASS CASH PRIZES** will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that breed is over, and the show Superintendent to be advised at once. The Show Superintendent and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the breed is over.

**\*CRC Judge's Awards:** At the judges discretion, CRC Judge's Awards will be awarded to a maximum of 10% of the Best of Breed entry, including Winners Dog, Winners Bitch, Veteran Dog and Veteran Bitch with no limitations as to sex. The 10% is in addition to the two CRC Judge's Awards automatically given to the Best of Breed and the Best of Opposite Sex. Only those dogs exhibited in the Best of Breed class will be eligible for CRC Judge's Awards. All award winners will receive a Rosette.

**Bred-by-Exhibitor Class eligibility:** All dogs entered in the Bred-by-Exhibitor Class must be individually registered with the AKC. The Person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. To exhibit in this class, family member must be a breeder and owner of record.

### Non-Regular Classes (Involving Single Dog Entries)

#### VETERAN DOG VETERAN BITCH

**7 years & under 9 years; 9 years & under 11 years; 11 years & under 13 years; 13 years and over**  
A Class for Dogs and a class for bitches seven years of age and older.  
Dog/Bitches entered in Veteran Class need not be intact. Spayed and Neutered animals are eligible. Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

#### WORKING DOG WORKING BITCHES

A Class for Dogs and a class for Bitches with working/performance titles. The Dog/Bitch must have earned one or more of the following AKC titles: CD, RN, TD, HS, NA, NAJ, NAP, NJP, NF, NFP or an American Rottweiler Club CS. Spayed and Neutered animals are ineligible to be entered in this class. Champions of Record are eligible to enter. Winners of these classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete for Best of Breed.

**BEST OF BREED COMPETITION:** The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition. Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owners records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the Owner's Records.

#### CRC JUDGE'S AWARDS OF MERIT

**Non-Regular Classes (Involving Multiple Dog Entires)**

**Stud Dog Class** - For Stud Dog and two of their Get. Stud Dog must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The Owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be the owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition or some other non-regular class.

**Brood Bitch Class** - For Brood Bitch and two of their Produce. Brood Bitch must be entered in the Brood Bitch Class and must be shown in the ring with their Produce. The Owner of the Brood Bitch need not necessarily be the owner of the Produce. While the merits of the Brood Bitch are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Brood Bitch must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC Policy, or the standard for its breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed Competition or some other non-regular class.
