CLOSING DATE for entries 12:00 Noon ET, Wednesday, April 15, 2026 at Show Superintendent's Office, or when limits are reached, after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided for in Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules.

An AKC Recording and Service Fee of \$4.50 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club.

RETURNED CHECKS do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Superintendent will add a collection fee of \$20.00 to the amount of each returned check.

ONLINE ENTRIES for events produced by Rau Dog Shows can be made at raudog.co/entries

EMAILED, TELEGRAPH, and UNSIGNED ENTRIES CANNOT BE ACCEPTED.

ENTRIES NOT ON OFFICIAL AKC ENTRY FORMS AND PHOTOCOPIES OF ENTRY FORMS without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES will not be accepted.

CREDIT CARD ENTRIES, REGARDLESS OF METHOD SUBMITTED, are processed through the Fax program and will be charged a \$4.00 per dog per show processing fee.

RAU DOG SHOWS accepts entries for AKC events in accordance with the latest Agreement, entry form instructions & "Rules Applying to Dog Shows". Should these rules be updated or changed the most recent AKC rules take precedent in the event of a discrepancy in this document.

CHARGEBACKS will be considered a violation of the entry agreement and will be reported to the AKC compliance department for disciplinary action. Outstanding bad debts are grounds for rejection of future entry by the club or superintendent under AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows C11 S15.

ACKNOWLEDGMENT OF ENTRIES will be made as soon as practicable with tickets and/or identification cards. The person accompanying a dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received. **SHOULD SUCH ACKNOWLEDGMENT NOT BE RECEIVED BY THE EXHIBITOR** within a reasonable time, please notify Jim Rau Dog Shows, Ltd., 610-376-1880.

MAKE ALL CHECKS AND MONEY ORDERS PAYABLE TO JIM RAU DOG SHOWS, LTD. Please mail checks or money orders with entries. The Secretary assumes no responsibility for cash sent through the mail.

CANADIAN EXHIBITORS make fees payable in U.S. FUNDS.

NO ENTRY SHALL BE MADE AND NO ENTRY SHALL BE ACCEPTED WHICH SPECIFIES ANY CONDITIONS AS TO ITS ACCEPTANCE.

ENTRY FEES shall not be refunded in the event that a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES. We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.

DOGS MAY ARRIVE any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. **DOGS NOT REQUIRED** for further judging will be excused.

JUDGES WILL NOT WAIT FOR ANY DOG HOLDING UP A CLASS. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club and the superintendent have no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ALL DOGS PRESENT must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising ring.

FLOOR COVERING required under all crates in building/

CLASS CASH PRIZES will be paid in the ring to the person showing the dog. Claims for prize money must be made in the ring before the judging of that class is over, and the Show Secretary to be advised at once. The Show Secretary and Show-giving Club may disclaim any liability for cash prizes after the judging of the class is over.

THE SHOW COMMITTEE/SUPERINTENDENT will use due care and diligence for the welfare of dogs and exhibitors, but will not be responsible for, nor assume any liability in the event of an accident or misfortune to either dogs or exhibitors participating in this show.

Winners of the above classes, if otherwise undefeated, are eligible to compete in Best of Breed. BEST OF BREED COMPETITION: The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed Competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs that according to their owner's records have completed the requirements for a Championship but whose Championships are unconfirmed. The showing of dogs whose Championships are unconfirmed is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where a dog completed the requirements for a Championship according to the owner's records

NON-REGULAR CLASSES INVOLVING MULTIPLE DOG ENTRIES

STUD DOG. For Stud Dogs and two of their Get. Stud Dogs must be entered in the Stud Dog Class and must be shown in the ring with their Get. The owner of the Stud Dog need not necessarily be owner of the Get. While the merits of the Stud Dog are not to be considered in the placement of the entry, the Stud Dog must be examined to determine if it has a condition that would require its disqualification or excusal under the Dog Show Rules, AKC policy, or the standard for the breed. Get must be entered in a regular class, Best of Breed competition or some other non-regular class.

BROOD BITCH. Same as Best Stud Dog except substitute Brood Bitch for Stud dog and Produce for Get.
NOTE: As the judge's decision in the Stud Dog or Brood Bitch Class is based on the merits of more than one dog/bitch, no one of the dogs/bitches making up the entry judged first in these classes will be eligible to compete for Best of Breed by virtue of having won this class

SPECIAL RECOGNITION

AWARDS OF MERIT: All dogs presented in the Best of Breed Competition will be eligible for the CRC Judge's Award, excluding dogs already awarded BOB, BOS, SD, SB or BOW. The maximum number of CRC Judge's Awards that may be given will be 10% of the Best of Breed entry (standard rounding rules >-.5 round up, else round down.) These CRC Judge's Awards may be chosen by the Breed Judge and presented with no consideration to sex.

BEST BRED BY EXHIBITOR: BRED-BY-EXHIBITOR (BBE) CLASS ELIGIBILITY - 1) All dogs entered in the Bred-By Class must be individually registered with the AKC. 2) The person handling the dog must be a breeder of record of the dog and an owner of record of the dog. 3) To exhibit in this class, family members must be a breeder and owner of record.

After Best of Breed, Selects, Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of Bred by Exhibitor Dog/Bitch classes and any dog in the Best of Breed ring that has declared themselves eligible at the time of the entry (including WD, WB, BOBs, & Veterans), compete for Best Bred by exhibitor. If Best of Breed is declared eligible, that entry is automatically Best Bred by Exhibitor. Exhibitors MUST enter their chosen class and also check the BBE Box on the entry blank to be eligible. All BOB eligible entries will be indicated by a hashtag (#) in the catalog.

BEST PUPPY: After Best of Breed, Selects, & Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of 6-9, 9-12, and Bred by Exhibitor Puppy classes compete for Best Bred Puppy. If Best of Winners is from one of the 6-9, 9-12, or Bred by Exhibitor Puppy classes that entry is automatically Best Puppy.

BEST VETERAN: After Best of Breed, Selects, & Awards of Merit are chosen, the winners of various Veteran classes compete for Best Veteran. If Best of Breed is from one of the Veteran classes that entry is automatically Best Veteran.

Dogs entered in the Amateur-Owner-Handler class will automatically be marked as eligible to compete in the NOHS. Eligible dogs will be identified by an asterisk in the judge's book, steward's book & the catalog. Dogs must be handled throughout the breed level competition for the regular show by an eligible owner. Professional handlers*, household members and current assistants** to professional handlers may not exhibit the dog in any NOHS competition during the entire show. *Professional handlers are defined as any person who belongs or has belonged to a professional handlers' organization, distributed rate cards, or otherwise advertised or represented themselves as handling dogs for pay within the last five years. **A current assistant is defined as anyone employed by a professional handler on a full-time basis or assisting a professional handler at the show or any time during the cluster/weekend. Current assistants that are eligible to compete in Junior Showmanship (meet age & amateur status requirements) may participate in NOHS.

JUNIOR SHOWMANSHIP COMPETITION

MASTER CLASS: This Class will be for boys and girls who are at least 9 years old and under 18 years on the day of the show, and who have won the 10 Best Junior wins with competition from the Open Class to be eligible to enter the Limited Class Competition. The calendar for this class will consistent with the eligibility dates for the AKC National Championship. All Juniors meeting the criteria for this class are required to enter the Master Class and may change their entry the day of the show if entries have already closed. Once the eligibility time frame for that year has passed all participants return to the Open Class to complete for the following year.

The Jaedyn Annual Volunteer Therapy Award

I would like to give you a little background about our Jaedyn. Jaedyn was a natural born therapy dog. She had a special gift to know when someone needed her most.

She Changed many lives through her years of service visiting patients at hospitals, rehab centers, children's wards, psychiatric units and hospice. She even saved my mom's life by detecting her heart disease before she even knew what was wrong. Her instincts were spot on.

One particular visit a patient asked " does her name mean anything?" I answered, "yes it means God Hears" she threw her arms around Jaedyn's neck and sobbed "I thought God forgot me a long time ago." The doctors told me as we were leaving that Jaedyn had just done what the doctors had been unable to do. That Jaedyn had given the women the breakthrough the doctors had been hoping for.

So this award is in honor of Jaedyn who passed away in 2021 from Osteosarcoma, and all the rottweilers that change people's lives through their love and dedication to helping people in need.

This award will be presented annually if the CRC board of directors and myself feel a dog and team has met the following criteria as set by Maureen and Doreen Sullivan the sponsors of the award. One recipient will receive a trophy (that is yours to keep) and their names placed on the perpetual trophy that will remain with CRC.

1. The human and dog team must be a member of a recognized organization (can be local or national). You must provide proof of membership.
2. Must Be a Rottweiler
3. Therapy work cannot be done during the time you are being paid to be at work. You must be volunteering your time.
4. You can nominate Yourself however you must provide a letter from someone who runs the facility you volunteer at or who's life your dog has touched. I want to know how your dog made a positive impact on its community, the facility they volunteer at or how they have helped an individual get through a challenging time or provided comfort in an exceptional way.
5. The hours you have volunteered do not matter - the quality of the connection your dog has with the people does.
6. You do not need to be a member of CRC to win this award, but you must be willing to attend the specialty to receive it.

Jaedyn was mine and my mother's heart so in her honor please send in your applications. The CRC board will choose the person that they feel best meets the criteria above. Please remember this award is about the quality of therapy work you do not the quantity. It's about the human canine connection and how our dogs can heal people in ways that doctors can't.

Recognizing that periodically reaffirming our shared values strengthens our community, the revised code will be shared widely to highlight the foundational values and principles that define the sport.

- Sportspeople always place the welfare of their dog above all else.
- Sportspeople prioritize the long-term health and preservation of their breed, making decisions that reflect a deep commitment to responsible breeding and ownership.
- Sportspeople respect the history, traditions and integrity of the sport of purebred dogs.
- Sportspeople conduct themselves in a manner that reflects positively on the sport, the American Kennel Club, and themselves.
- Sportspeople appreciate, encourage and support all who associate with and participate in the sports by fostering an environment where respect, equity, inclusion, and courtesy are foundational.
- Sportspeople understand, uphold and abide by all AKC bylaws, rules, regulations and policies.
- Sportspeople contribute to a positive atmosphere at events by avoiding negative gossip, disparagement, or unsportsmanlike behavior.
- Sportspeople extend their values of civility, fairness, and respect to all digital and social media platforms.
- Sportspeople actively support the education and mentorship of newcomers, helping them learn the rules, values, and traditions of the sport in a respectful way.
- Sportspeople recognize that they are role models in the sport, and strive to lead by example through humility, kindness, and ethical conduct.
- Sportspeople treat fellow exhibitors, judges, officials, volunteers, spectators, and AKC staff with dignity and respect, regardless of experience, background, or differences in opinion.
- Sportspeople are committed to fair play, honesty, courtesy, and competition, approaching both winning and losing with grace.
- Sportspeople understand that strong competition and civility can—and should—coexist. They appreciate the quality of their competitors, and the effort put forth by others.
- Sportspeople uphold their responsibilities to the sport of purebred dogs and refuse to let personal gain or self-interest influence their decisions or behavior.
- The sportsperson judges only on the merits of the dogs and considers no other factors.
- The sportsperson judge or exhibitor accepts constructive criticism.
- The sportsperson exhibitor declines to enter or exhibit under a judge where it might reasonably appear that the judge's placements could be based on something other than the merits of the dogs.
- The sportsperson exhibitor refuses to compromise the impartiality of a judge.
- Sportspeople are willing to share honest and open appraisals of both the strengths and weaknesses of their breeding stock.
- Sportspeople decline to exploit any positions of authority or recognition for personal advantage.
- Sportspeople appreciate those that have gone before them and realize they are responsible for maintaining and enhancing the sport for future generations.
